How to Choose the Right Grant

Erasmus+ KA1 Short-Term Projects

✓ *For schools starting out in Erasmus+*

Duration: **6–18 months**

Max participants: **30**

Activities:

- Staff mobility
- Courses & job shadowing
 - ✓ *Simple application process*

Erasmus+ KA1 Accreditation





Long-term strategic funding

Duration: **5 years** (2021–2027)

Activities:

- Staff & pupil mobilities
- Long-term exchanges
 - ✓ *Recognised Erasmus+ school*
 - ✓ *Annual simplified grant requests*

KA1 Short-Term vs. Accreditation

Feature	KA1 Short-Term	KA1 Accreditation
Duration	6–18 months	5 years
Strategy Required	 No	 Yes
Max Participants	~30	No limit
Application	Simple	Requires plan

KA2 Small-Scale Partnerships



Perfect for beginners and small organisations

Duration: **6–24 months**

Minimum **2 organisations from 2 countries**

Lump-sum funding: **€30,000 or €60,000**

Focus: **Networking & sharing practices**

KA2 Cooperation Partnerships



For experienced organisations

Duration: 1–3 years

Minimum 3 organisations from 3 countries

Funding: Up to €400,000

Focus: Innovation, high-impact outputs

Feature	Small-Scale Partnerships	Cooperation Partnerships
Duration	6–24 months	1–3 years
Budget	€30–60k	Up to €400k
Complexity	Low	High
Minimum Partners	2 countries	3 countries
